AIRPORT SECURITY 3-1-1

3 ounce bottle or less (by volume)

1 quart-sized, clear, plastic, zip-top bag

1 bag per passenger placed in screening bin.

All liquids and gels that you intend take into the cabin of the aircraft in your carry on bag, must be placed in one zip lock bag.
