## SBU vs. MISSOURI WESTERN

### Today's Matchup

The Southwest Baptist Bearcats (8-7, 4-3) are coming off 68-65 victory over Pittsburg State at home on Tuesday.

Missouri Western (10-5, 3-4) comes into tonight's game after dropping three of its last four, including two straight. The Griffons lost at Missouri Southern Wednesday, 91-83.

### SBU's Last Time Out

SBU pulled out its third straight victory at home after defeating No. 23 Pittsburg State on Tuesday, 68-65.

The Bearcats (8-7, 4-3) were down 36-35 at the half and were down by eight (49-41) with 15:09 to play in the game. SBU used a 10-1 run to go ahead 51-50 on a David Coutchie layup with 10:56 to go in the second period.

The Gorillas (12-4, 4-3) went back on top by five with 7:46 left, but SBU never gave up, charging back to tie the game at 57 with 4:13 on the clock. This time, the Gorillas responded with a four-point run, but SBU chiseled back to a one point deficit twice, the last time with 1:55 left (65-64).

The Bearcats went ahead with 1:16 on the clock after David Coutchie hit a 20-foot jumper from the right side of the basket. SBU led 66-65 when PSU's Greg Campbell missed a three-point shot with :58 left. D.J. Hogue grabbed the rebound, Coutchie missed the jumper with 20 seconds left, but Kendrick Jackson got the rebound and the putback to put SBU up 68-65 with 19 ticks on the clock.

A turnover by PSU's Tommy Vosseler with :08 left and the steal by Jackson sealed the victory for the Bearcats.

SBU was led in the victory by Ryan Stock with 15 points. Arthur Trousdel added 13 and Kendrick Jackson added 12 points. He had a team-high 10 rebounds as well.

The Bearcats shot .483 from the floor (28-58), .333 from the arc (3-9) and .692 from the charity stripe (9-13).

### MWSC's Last Time Out

The Griffons were outscored 50-30 in the first half of the game in Joplin on Wednesday. The Lions of Missouri Southern connected on 66.7 percent of their shots in the first half of the contest.

Despite outscoring the Lions 53-41 in the second period, MWSC could not overcome the halftime deficit. However, the Griffons used a 10-2 rally over a two minute stretch in the second half to get within eight, but the Lions hit the last 10 free throws to seal the victory.

Leading MWSC in the defeat was Damon Bailey with 24 points. Tee Mason added 16 and Matt Grove added 10 to round out the Griffons in double figures. Larry Taylor led the team with six rebounds.

### SBU This Season

Leading the team this season is Trousdel with 15.8 points per game. He is second in rebounding with 6.4 per contest.

Leading the team in rebounding is Kendrick Jackson with 6.8 per outing. He adds 6.6 points per contest. Also averaging in double figures is David Couthie (11.8), D.J. Hogue (11.9) and Ryan Stock (11.3). Stock is averaging 6.6 rebounds and is first in the league in assists per game (5.87). He is third in the MIAA in steals (2.27).

SBU is averaging .466 from the field, .330 from the arc and .756 from the charity stripe. SBU is tops in the league in free throw percentage.

Trousdell will miss Saturday's game

as SBU officials review his status.

### MWSC This Season

Leading the Griffons this season is Damon Bailey with 17.4 points per game. He is also the team leader in rebounds with 7.2 per contest. Also scoring in double figures for MWSC is Larry Taylor (15.3) and Mario Davis (11.2). Davis adds 6.9 rebounds per outing while Taylor is averaging 5.2 boards.

The Griffons are shooting .455 from the field, .343 from the arc and .726 from the charity stripe.

### In the Nation...

Arthur Trousdell has the highest field percentage in the nation during a single game. Trousdell hit 10-of-11 on Dec. 30 against Missouri-Rolla for a .909 percentage. He is tied with Shamar Green of Clarion.

Ryan Stock is tied for No. 24 in the nation for assists per game (5.87).

The team is No. 13 in the nation in free throw percentage hitting 75.6 percent from the charity stripe.

SBU is tied for first in the nation in free throw percentage in a game.
