## SBU VS. CENTRAL MISSOURI STATE

**The Game:** The Bearcats will host Central Missouri State on Saturday, Feb. 9 at 3:30 p.m. SBU (10-11, 4-9) comes into the game after losing 89-52 at Washburn. The Mules enter the game with a 78-65 win over Missouri Southern at home. Also, the game is SBU's Change Drive, sponsored by the Student-Athlete Advisory Committee. Fans will be able to donate staples, such as flour, sugar, etc., or they can make monetary donations in order to help Intervention Ministries.

**The series:** The Mules lead the series between the two schools 18-15. SBU lost to CMSU earlier this season in overtime, 89-88. The Bearcats have won four of the last eight meetings with the Mules, including sweeping CMSU last year.

**Last time out:** Bearcats jump out to 11-3 lead at 16:55 mark, but Ichabods close half on 32-13 spurt. WU uses 14-0 run in the second half to pull away. Leading SBU was Igor Majoros with 14 points and four rebounds. L.V. Hill was second on the team with eight points and tied Majoros with four rebounds. Shelby Tonnies missed the game because of his ankle.

Central Missouri State had four members in double figures on Wednesday as they upset No. 15 Missouri Southern. The Mules took the lead with 7:47 left in the first half on a jumper by Vince Haynes and never looked back. The Mules led 44-29 at the half. Leading CMSU was Phil Gettinger with 20 points and Mark DeBaun with eight rebounds. Also scoring in double figures were Haynes (18), DeBaun (14) and Jeremy McFall (11).

**Southwest Baptist:** The Bearcats have won three of their last five games and hope to continue. SBU is tied for seventh place with Missouri-Rolla.

The Bearcats are 7-3 at home overall and 3-3 in conference play. With a win, the Bearcats will be tied with CMSU for sixth.

Leading the Bearcats is Igor Majoros with 17.5 points per game. He adds 6.6 rebounds per contest. At the top of the team in rebounds is Shelby Tonnies who is averaging 8.4 rebounds per contest. He is adding 10.2 points each night.

Also scoring in double figures is Ryan Stock with 12.8 points per game, David Henderson averages 11.3 points per contest and David Coutchie adds 10.2 points per game.

Stock is fourth in the nation, and second in the MIAA, with 6.9 assists per game. Stock is No. 21 in the nation with 2.6 steals per game. Majoros' .859 free throw percentage is No. 29 in the nation.

The team's rebound margin of 7.2 per game is No. 19 in the country.

SBU is shooting .444 from the field, .369 from the three-point arc and .685 from the charity stripe.

**Central Missouri State:** The Mules enter the game winning

only two of their last five games.

Central Missouri State hopes to sweep the Bearcats for the second time in three years.

Leading CMSU this season is Vince Haynes with 14.3 points per game. Mark DeBaun leads the team with 8.7 rebounds per contest.

Also scoring in double figures is Phil Gettinger with 14.2 points per game and DeBaun with 14.1 points per outing. Gettinger is second on the team with 5.8 rebounds per game.

The team is shooting .442 from the field, .336 from the three-point arc and .688 from the free throw line.
