## SBU VS. PITTSBURG STATE

**The Game:** The Bearcats will host Pittsburg State on Tuesday, Feb. 19 at 7:45 p.m. in Davison Field House. The Bearcats (12-12, 6-10) are coming off a 99-92 loss in overtime to No. 9 Northwest Missouri State. PSU (15-9, 9-7) enters the game after a 64-56 win at Truman.

**The series:** The Gorillas hold a 20-14 advantage over the Bearcats, including a 2-1 series record last season and a 80+64 victory on Jan. 23 of this year.. The Gorillas defeated the Bearcats on Jan. 20, 2001, 93-63, in Bolivar. However the Bearcats sought revenge handing PSU its only loss at home on the season on Feb. 17 with a 75-66 victory in John Lance Arena. PSU won nine days later in Pittsburg during the first round of the conference tournament, 98-81.

**Last time out:** SBU traveled to Maryville on Saturday and almost walked away with a victory. The Bearcats were down by three with 3.7 left in regulation when they inbounded the ball to junior David Henderson who traveled the length of the court and knocked down a three-pointer from 25 feet to send the game to overtime. The Bearcats eventually lost, 99-92, to the No. 9 team in the nation, but four SBU players had 19 points on the evening. Henderson, Ryan Stock, Igor Majoros and Shelby Tonnie's. NWMSU put SBU away at the line hitting 33 of 39 free throws. The Bearcats were 16 of 21.

Pittsburg State led the Bulldogs at halftime on Saturday, 27-20 and held on to win their second straight game on the road. Leading the Gorillas was Cedric Brooks with 20 points. Also scoring in double figures was Max Ruark (18) and Dan Stanley (12). They outrebounded Truman 49-34.

**Southwest Baptist:** The Bearcats solidify a spot in the MIAA postseason tournament with a win tonight over Pittsburg State. The Bearcats are 9-3 at home this season and have won the last three games in Davison Field House.

SBU is playing to keep sole possession of sixth place in the conference and still have to travel to Missouri Western on Saturday to wrap up the end of the regular season. The Bearcats, supposing they make the conference tournament, will have to travel out of town next Tuesday, Feb. 26 to open their postseason title bid. If the standings remain the same, the Bearcats would probably travel to Missouri Southern.

Leading the Bearcats this season is Igor Majoros with 17.5 points per game. He also has been averaging 6.9 rebounds per contest and is shooting .458 from the field and .864 from the charity stripe. He has also knocked down .402 percent of his three-point shots.

Ryan Stock leads the team with 165 assists and 62 steals. He is second on the team with 13.7 points per game and third in rebounds with 6.5 per contest.

Leading the Bearcats in rebounds is Shelby Tonnie's with 8.7 boards per outing. He is averaging 14.4 points per game

and has really come out the last few games.

Also scoring in double figures is David Henderson with 10.9 points per game and David Coutchie with 10.0 points per contest.

SBU is shooting .439 from the field, .366 from the arc and .691 at the line.

**Pittsburg State:** The Gorillas enter the game needing to win these last two games to have a chance to host a first round playoff game.

PSU is 4-6 on the road this season and has posted an 10-11 record on the road the last two seasons.

Leading the Gorillas in 2001-02 is Cedric Brooks with 19.5 points per game. Max Ruark leads the team with 8.5 rebounds per contest.

Also averaging in double figures is Jai Pradia with 13.2 points per game and Dan Stanley with 13.1 points per contest.

The Gorillas are shooting .481 from the field, .327 from the three-point arc and .680 from the charity stripe.
