If the right teams win and lose on Saturday, there could be a four-way tie for last place between UMissouri-Rolla, MWSC, Truman, and SBU. Currently, SBU is a game out of going to the MIAA Tournament. The top eight teams receive the chance to play in Kansas City.

Looking at the records, UMR, MWSC, and TSU all have 3-8 records. If SBU can defeat MWSC, the Griffons would be 3-9 while SBU would be 3-9 in the MIAA. If UMR loses to PSU and TSU loses to CMSU, they will both be 3-9 in the MIAA. Then, it will be a race to the finish for the Sonic/MIAA Tournament.

CAREER GAME

In the loss to Truman, sophomore Arthur Trousdell had his best game in a Bearcat uniform. He had 24 points and 15 rebounds to lead SBU. He also had three assists, three blocks, and two steals. He shot 56% from the floor (9-16) and was six-of-seven from the free throw line. He also played in 37 minutes of the game. His previous best was 23 points and 14 rebounds.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS

Senior David Henderson has 30 blocks on the season. With this number, he is now #4 for blocks in a season. He just surpassed Shelby Tonnies, who had 29 blocks in a season. He needs two more blocks to tie John Massey and nine more to tie Ian Pinder for second. David Harris is #1 with 164 blocks in one season.

With 54 career blocks, he is second all-time on the SBU list. Harris is #1 with 164

#1 IN THE MIAA

Senior Jarrett Brown is now #1 in the MIAA in three-point FGs made. He is averaging 3.16 per game. He has mad 60 on the year and hit seven three-pointers vs. Truman in their first meeting, which was one short of the SBU record for three's in a game.

The Coaches

Southwest Baptist

Ron Nunnally - Interim Head Coach

Nunnally has been a part of the SBU men's basketball program for four years. He came on Coach Archer's staff in 1999 as a student assistant and then in the 2000 season he was promoted to an assistant coach. Nunnally graduated from SBU in 1999 but played basketball for CMSU where he was part of the 1984 National Championship team. In the championship game, Nunnally scored 38 points and was named the MVP. He went on to play professionally in Australia and Malaysia. He won his first game against Missouri Western on January 24th.

Missouri Western

Tom Smith

Smith is in his 16th year at MWSC and 29th overall in coaching. Last year he led the Griffons to the Sonic/MIAA Tournament championship and now has posted 490 career wins. He has been named the MIAA "Coach of the Year" twice and led MWSC to five straight NCAA top 10 finishes in Division II from 1989 through the 1994.

LAST TIME OUT

Southwest Baptist

SBU did not hit a shot in the last minute and half as Truman State came away with a two-point win, 60-58. TSU's Grant Agbo hit a layup with 1:10 to go for the lead as TSU went on for the victory. Arthur Trousdell was the leading scorer with 24 points and 15 rebounds.

Missouri Western

MWSC lost to Emporia State, 70-53, in Emporia, Kansas. ESU snapped a 16-game losing streak to MWSC that dated back to the 1996 season. DeVonte King was the leading scorer with 16 points.

ARCHER RESIGNS

Due to ongoing health concerns, men's basketball head coach Darin Archer has resigned his position as head men's basketball coach. Assistant Coach Ron Nunnally will take over as interim head coach.

Archer coached in nine games this season with his final game being against Northwest Missouri State on December 30th.
