WE'RE RANKED

The Southwest Baptist University Lady Bearcats were recognized for their hard work and efforts early this week when the NCAA South Regional poll came out. They were #9 in the poll and the top eight make the NCAA Tournament. Counting SBU, there were five MIAA teams in the regional rankings. Emporia State was #1 followed by NWMSU at #3 and then Washburn #8, SBU #9, and CMSU #10.

WHERE DID IT GO

The Lady Bearcats have not had much luck this year from beyond the arc. Against Washburn, they only shot 23% and now are shooting .304 on the season. Amber Wheeler has taken the most attempts at 97 and is shooting .320 while Jennifer Clymore has the best percentage at .458 (11-24).

HALFTIME SCORE

SBU has been behind in six games this year at half and only came away with one win. Against St. Mary's, in San Antonio, Texas, SBU was down 19-16 before coming back to win in overtime. 63-62. The five losses have come against NE State Univ., NWMSU, ESU, MSSU, and WU.

DRY RUNS

In the past two games, cold shooting has put SBU in a hard situation. They have had two dry spells the last two games in which they have only hit one bucket in a seven minute span. Against Washburn, Rebekah Douchant hit a three-pointer at the buzzer to give SBU their first field goal from the floor since the 7:42 mark. Then, versus Missouri Southern, a 15-0 run over seven put the Lady Lions ahead for good as SBU did not hit a shot from the floor. SBU shot 30% from the floor vs. MSSU and 36% vs. WU.

The Coaches

Southwest Baptist

Jim Middleton

Entering his 10th year at Southwest Baptist, head coach Jim Middleton will try to return the Lady Bearcats to the NCAA Tournament while pursuing a MIAA Championship. He is the winningest coach in SBU history with a .659 winning percentage heading into the 2003-04 season. He has successfully guided the Lady Bearcats to five NCAA Tournaments and appeared in the tournament four times in a row from the 1997-98 through the 2001-02 season. In the 2001-02 season, SBU went to their first ever Sweet 16, too. Under his tenure, SBU has enjoyed great fan support. SBU finished fourth nationally in attendance in the 1995-96 season and eighth in the 2000-01 season. He has produced three all-Americans and been named the District 6 "Coach of the Year" once. He has also went to the MIAA Tournament all nine years he has been the head coach.

Middleton is a 1985 graduate of Southwest Missouri State University. He went on to be a graduate assistant at SMS in women's basketball and received a master's degree in educational administration in 1987. After a year as the strength coach for the SMS men's basketball team, Middleton went to West Plains H.S. in 1989 as the girl's head coach. In two years, he compiled a record of 33-18. In the 1990-91 season, they finished 20-6 and won the South Central Association title while being named the coach of the year. He left West Plains and became a full-time assistant coach under Cheryl Burnett at SMS. He enjoyed three years under Burnett before moving on to SBU in 1994. At SMS, he was part of three conference championships and NCAA Tournaments along with advancing to the 1992 NCAA Final Four.

He has an overall record of 179-92 in his 10th year at SBU.

Missouri Western

Dave Silfer

Dave Silfer begins his 9th season as the head womens basketball coach at Missouri Western. Under Silfer's direction, the Griffons have run off seven consecutive appearance in the NCAA South Central Regional Tournament, have won two Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association regular season titles and claimed two MIAA postseason tournament titles. He has a 14-year record of 362-90. Previous to MWSC, he was at NAIA Mount Mercy College.

LAST TIME OUT

Southwest Baptist

SBU dropped their second MIAA game in a row to #9 Washburn, 63-41. The Lady Bearcats were only down 10 at halftime, 30-20, but for the second game in a row they hit a dry spell in the second half. With 7:42 to go, Mercer hit the final shot from the floor until Rebekah Douchant's three-pointer at the buzzer. Mercer was the leading scorer with nine points.

Missouri Western

MWSC came from behind to post a 79-72 win over Pittsburg State to improve to 12-4 and 4-3 in the MIAA. Four Lady Griffons were in double figures as Eldra Paixao led the way with 22 points. Paixao gave MWSC the lead for good with 13:00 to go in the second half as they went on for the win.
