Purpose: Department of Athletic Training's student provides the Athletic Department with support in the athletic training services provided to the student-athlete. Acts as assistant to the ACI and/or CI in the department of athletic training's education program. Is directly supervised by the ACI and/or CI in the provision of these services.

Essential Functions:

- Adheres to the Department of Athletic Training's Policy and Procedure Manual
- Provides athletic training services to the student-athlete under the direct supervision of their assigned ACI/CI.
- Adheres to the Athletic Training Services Policy and Procedure Manual
- Adheres to all other assigned clinical sites policy and procedure manuals.
- Performs duties as assigned by their ACI that pertain to the normal function and operation of the primary clinical site (SBU's Athletic Training Rooms)
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Department Chair.
- Be able to meet or be accommodated to meet the ADA Technical Standards.

Supervision: This position receives direction and direct supervision from the Clinical Coordinator, Head Athletic Trainer, ACI's and CI's.

Evaluation: The athletic training student is evaluated annually within this position description by the Clinical Coordinator.

Education and Experience:

Required: Admission into the program.

Working Conditions:

Must be able to work in typical Intercollegiate athletic training environment.

Physical Requirements:

In exercising the functions of this job the incumbent should be able to exert up to 80 lbs. of force occasionally and/or up to 10 lbs. of force frequently and/or a negligible amount of force constantly to move objects.
