Summer Moves in Hutchens Library Brings New Periodical Shelving & Workstations

Hutchens Library added two ranges of periodical shelving and relocated four ranges of book shelving (including oversized books) this summer.



Two new computer work stations were placed at central locations designated by Ed Walton, acting dean of Libraries, in response to student input. The input was gathered from the annual

library satisfaction surveys that are filled out in class by students each year.



The new workstations have the same software as the library computer labs and print study tables moved to the oversized book area.



Two new computer workstations have been set up in the central area of the Hutchens Library.

- These workstations have the same software as computers in Lab L136
- Authorized usernames and passwords are required on these workstations as with other library and lab computers
