

LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR THE INTERNET VERSION OF SBPI

Southwest Baptist University Library hereby grants the subscriber to the cumulative Internet version of the SOUTHERN BAPTIST PERIODICAL INDEX a non-transferable license for the use of the database in accordance with the terms set forth below.

- **Access and Use**

Purchasers of a one-concurrent-user option (Plan B) must be able to supply a stable IP address for one computer.

Purchasers of a site license are granted access by all IP addresses of the single entity (college, university, seminary, agency, school, church). This extends to all current employees, faculty, and registered students who must use passwords to access the entity's network, including those given legitimate access to the network "off-campus" by a proxy server. Registered guest patrons of the entity's library are also granted access. Permission is not granted for remote access by the general public.

Authorized users, including walk-in users of the entity's library facilities, may print and download selected records for personal research or scholarly purposes in accordance with the fair use provisions of the copyright law. They may not create derivative bibliographies for commercial gain.

- **No Warranties**

The University Library provides the database in an "as is" condition. Though every effort is made to create accurate citations and notes, the library provides no warranty and incurs no responsibility for the results of searches made by users, beyond the commitment to correct any discovered errors for a subsequent issue of the database.

- **Technical operations**

Subscribers to the Internet version should name a staff person who will be responsible for informing the SBPI Office in a timely manner of legitimate IP addresses for the entity and communicating changes to that list. This person will also be the contact person for connectivity issues. Local computer services personnel will be responsible for effecting proper connections to the SBPI web site and affording print options to local printers.

- **Subscriptions**

Outdated discs from previous CD-ROM subscribers need not be returned; they should be destroyed once access to the Internet version is up and running. If a subscription is canceled, all extant copies should be returned and any related files on the network or work stations should be deleted. This provision is waived for an entity that has contributed its publications for indexing into the database.

- Software

Purchaser may not alter, de-compile, disassemble, or reverse assemble or compile the program in order to derive its source code.
