The Common Library Platform

The CLP, a project by MOBIUS [the Missouri Online Bibliographic Information User System] does just that. The CLP shares millions of



books and resources with thousands of people at a fraction of the cost of traditional methods of interlibrary loan. The purpose of the CLP is to provide easy access to information and rapid delivery of library materials throughout the state of Missouri.

So how does it work?

Through the Internet, the CLP permits students and faculty of nearly every academic library in Missouri to connect directly to a single statewide database and provides direct services including search retrieval. Then if the resource is needed, it can be delivered overnight between member libraries through the use of Lanter Delivery services.

This sharing delivers more resources to faculty and students in a fast, convenient and accessible manner which is more than any one member library could afford to make available on their own.
