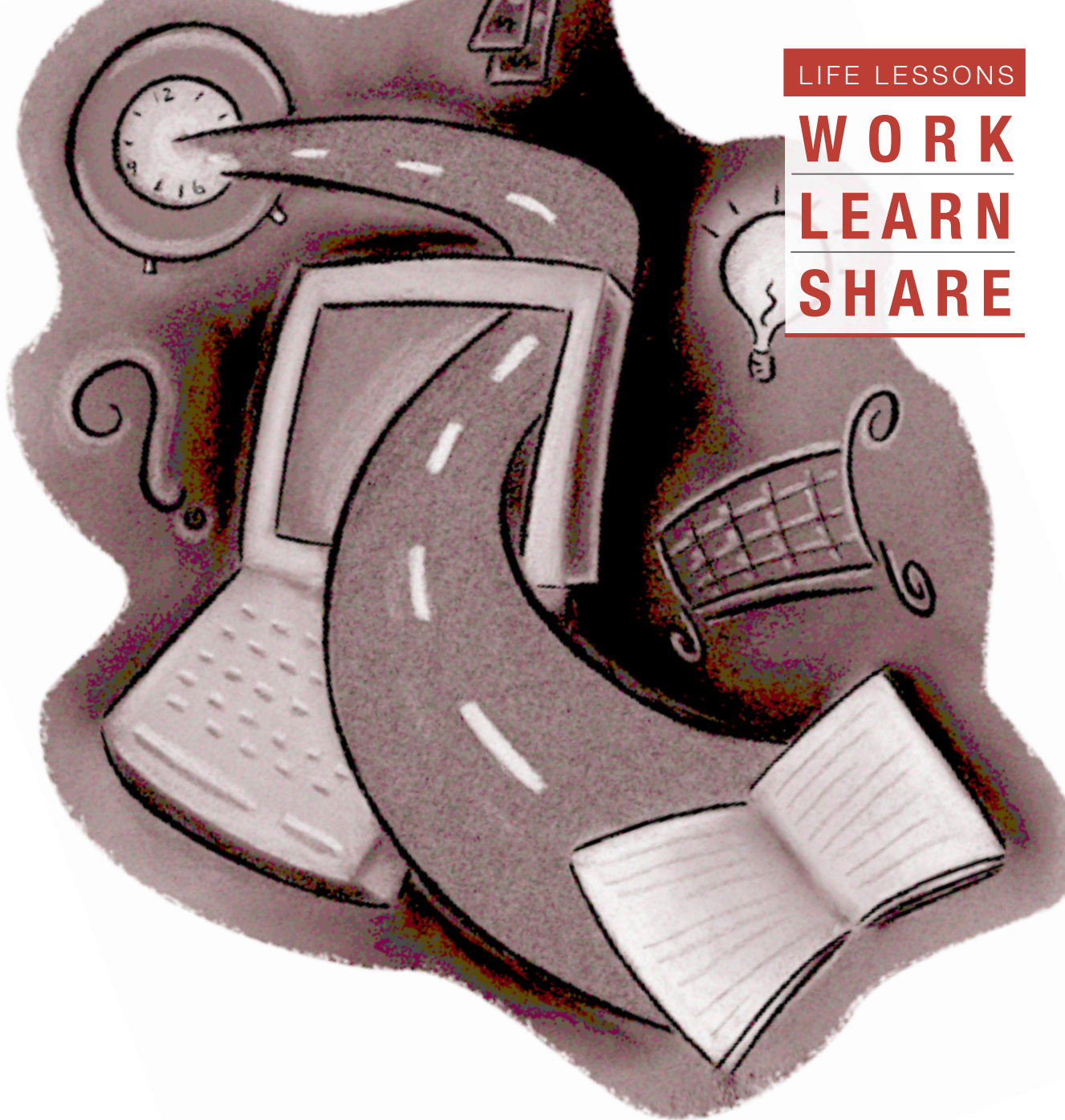

MOBIUS is a consortium of academic libraries with 56 member colleges and universities in the state of Missouri. Its purpose is to make available library materials and information in an accessible, cost effective and with quick delivery using the power of the Internet and technology.

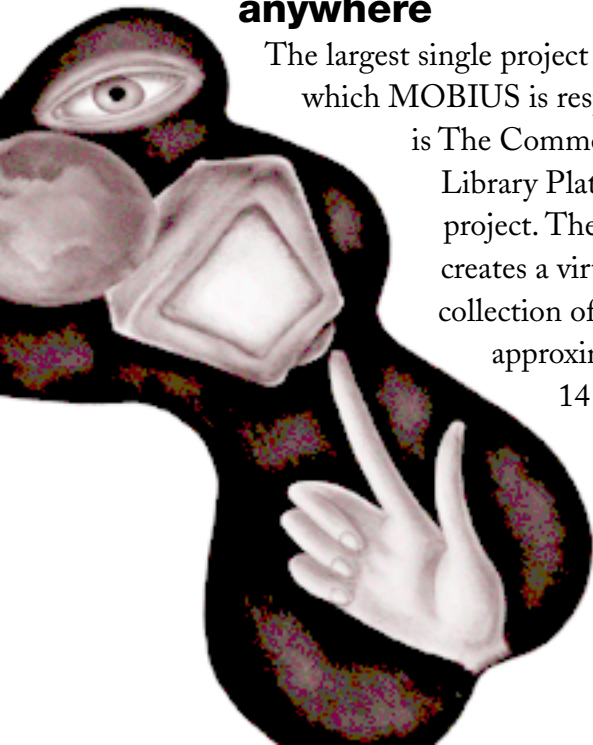
