Admission Policies

FRESHMAN ADMISSION

1. An SBU applicant must present one of the following:
 - Proof of graduation from an accredited or approved high school, or
 - A home-school transcript.
2. Additionally, students must meet two of these three qualifiers
 - 2.50 high school GPA
 - 21 ACT/990 SAT (combined critical reading and mathematics scores) score, or
 - Top 50% of high school rank in class.
3. In order to help one succeed at SBU the following high school subjects are strongly recommended (13 units): English (4 units), mathematics (3 units), social studies (2 units), natural science (2 units), electives (2 units of foreign language or computer science or 2 additional units from English, mathematics, social studies, or natural sciences).

CONDITIONAL ADMISSION

Students who do not meet minimum criteria for freshman admission may be accepted with conditions. An applicant must be a graduate of an accredited or approved high school or present an acceptable secondary certificate (e.g., the GED). Admittance with condition as a degree-seeking student, may be based on a further review. Conditions will be detailed in writing from the Director of Admissions.

STARTING THE ADMISSION PROCESS:

- Submit the application for admission and the \$30 non-refundable application fee.
- Send ACT/SAT scores to Southwest Baptist University (ACT Code - 2368; SAT Code - 6664).
- Send an official high school transcript or copy of GED. Send official college transcripts of all course work attempted, including dual credit hours, if applicable. These must be submitted from each college at which credit was attempted.

COMPLETING THE ADMISSION PROCESS:

- Submit the enrollment deposit.
- Submit a housing contract, which is provided by the office of admissions, once you apply for admission.
- Register for classes! Registration begins in April for the summer terms/fall semester and in November for January/spring semesters.

NOTE: Transcripts, test scores, enrollment deposit and housing contracts are required before students can register for classes and receive University housing assignments. Students applying for the fall semester should submit these items before December 31 in order to have their housing request given the highest priority. Students applying for January or spring semesters should have this information submitted by October 15.

ENROLLMENT DEPOSIT REFUND DEADLINES:

- May 1 for fall semester
- December 1 for Jan-term/spring semester
- May 1 for summer sessions
