The Itinerary...



Friday 19 March 2010 (D)

Depart for Munich

Depart Kansas City for your flight to Munich. Your flight may have one or two connections before reaching Munich.

Saturday 20 March 2010 (B, D)

Arrive in Munich/Overnight in Salzburg

On arrival in Munich you'll meet your Cultural Tour Consultants tour manager, board your private deluxe coach and depart for Salzburg, Austria. On arrival, meet your local guide and begin a sightseeing tour of the city. You'll see the Residenz and Mozart's birthplace among other sights (entrance to Mozart's birthplace included). The tour will end at the Salzburgdom where you will sing informally (pending confirmation). Continue on and check into your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Sunday 21 March 2010 (B, D)

Salzburg

After breakfast, transfer to a local church where you will participate in morning services (Salzburgdom to be requested). You'll have an independent lunch and time at leisure this afternoon to enjoy the beautiful city of Salzburg. A full concert will be arranged this evening in the area.

Monday 22 March 2010(B, D)

Salzburg

This morning you'll depart for Berchtesgaden. Arrive at the Salzburg Salt Mines where you will don the suits of the miners and slide into the mines for a fun and educational tour. You'll have some time in Berchtesgaden for an independent lunch and shopping. Return to Salzburg for dinner and overnight.

Tuesday 23 March 2010 (B, D)

Salzburg, Mondsee, Steyr

Board your coach and transfer to St. Florian Abbey. You'll arrive in time for a private organ concert before touring the Abbey. The tour will end in the Basilica where you will sing informally. After an independent lunch continue on to Mauthausen where you will pay tribute to the victims of the Nazi concentration camp once located here. Arrive in Steyr in the late afternoon and check into your hotel. A full concert will be arranged in Steyr this evening.

Wednesday 24 March 2010 (B, D)

Linz, Cesky Krumlov, Prague

Board your coach and depart for Cesky Krumlov in the Czech Republic, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most beautiful towns in southern Bohemia. You'll have the afternoon at leisure for an independent lunch and to explore the town before continuing on to Prague.

This morning you will transfer to the Prague Castle where you will spend the morning exploring the Old Royal Palace, Basilica of St. George the Golden Lane and St. Vitas Cathedral (entrances included). Your tour will continue across the Charles Bridge to old town where you will learn the history of the Jewish Quarter, once the largest Jewish ghetto in Europe and the old town of Prague. A full concert will be arranged tonight in Prague. Dinner is provided tonight in a local restaurant.
