

Frank and Maxine Meyers Pastoral Ministry Scholarship

The Frank and Maxine Meyers Pastoral Ministry Scholarship is established to support students preparing for the pastorate within the Southern Baptist denomination and within the Association of Reformed Churches of America (ARBCA/IRBS). Primary preference shall be given to those students demonstrating financial need according to the standards utilized by the University for determining need. Primary preference shall also be given to one or more students who are majoring in Christian Ministry with a Pastoral Ministry or Biblical Studies concentration, and who have a letter from their home church indicating they have made public their call to the ministry. Funding from the scholarship may be utilized at the undergraduate or graduate level as long as the above preferences are followed. Should no student exist or additional funding be available after students meeting the above criteria have been satisfied, scholarship funding may be utilized to support students preparing for the pastoral ministry at the discretion of the person responsible for overseeing the ministerial guidance program at the University.

The following application form is to be used by students currently enrolled in the Master of Arts in Christian Ministry program at SBU, and by prospective students currently applying to the program.
