

## **Church-Matching Scholarship Program**

The Southwest Baptist University Church-Matching scholarship is available to qualified students enrolled on the Bolivar campus. A student's home church may contribute any amount; SBU will match a maximum of \$500 per year (\$250 fall term, \$250 spring term). This application form is required for each participating student and must be signed by the pastor.

## **Program Guidelines**

- Church must initially complete a Church Agreement for the Church Matching Program.
- Student must be enrolled as a full time (minimum of 12 hours) undergraduate student on the Bolivar campus and maintain a minimum 2.000 GPA.
- Church may make only one payment per term/year.
- One form for each student is required each year.
- Church funds and form(s) must be received by SBU during the term for which the funds are intended. To benefit our students we recommend SBU receive your contribution(s) and form(s) by July 1 for the fall term/year and December 1 for the spring term.
- Matching funds cannot be credited to the student's account until church funds are received and the pastor has verified the origin of the contribution.
