Admission Criteria

To be considered as a candidate for admission into the program, a student must have completed and submitted the following: (All forms are available at <http://www.sbuniv.edu/academics/programs/athletic-training.php> )

1. ADA Technical Standards for Admission

2. Transcripts. Transfer students must submit Official Transcripts.
3. Directed Observer Evaluation Form. <http://www.sbuniv.edu/resources/documents/cosm/at-observer-evaluation-form.pdf>  
Transfer students, please have the form filled out by the ATC that signed off on most of their hour log.
4. Documentation of Directed Observation hours.
5. Essay – “Why do I want to become an Athletic Trainer”

After submission, acceptance into the program is based upon 6 weighted criteria. Students with the top scores will be considered for admission into the program. (Number submitted is based upon amount of eligible seats). The weighted criteria are:

1. Overall College Grade Point Average (1pt/.1pt GPA)	25 (2.5) to 40 (4.0) pts
2. Completion of Application Packet (2 pts/item)	20 points
3. Directed Observer Evaluation Form (4pts/category)	56 points
4. Interview with Admissions Committee (3 members)	84 points
5. Essay – <i>Why do I want to become an Athletic Trainer</i>	30 points
6. Overall Athletic Training Potential	20 points
<b>Maximum Total Possible Points</b>	<b>250 points</b>

Applications are due on/or before March 1st .
