## Retention and graduation rates for Southwest Baptist University

### Retention

Retention rates measure the percentage of first-time students who return to Southwest Baptist University to continue their studies the next fall.

#### Retention Rates for First-Time Students Pursuing Bachelor's Degrees

### Graduation

#### Overall Graduation and Transfer-Out Rates for Students Who Began Their Studies in Fall 2010

The overall graduation rate is the percentage of full-time, first-time degree-seeking students who complete a degree within 150% of "normal time" for completing the program in which they are enrolled. The transfer-out rate is the percentage of full-time, first-time students who transferred to another institution.
