This program graduated its first class in 2015. Consequently program effectiveness data for the required 5 year time frame for Southwest Baptist University is not yet established, however data from the last 3 years will be reported.

#### AMERICAN REGISTRY OF RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY (ARRT) PASS RATE

For the past 5 years (2010-2014), the ARRT exam pass rate for first time examinees was 99% (71 out of 72).

#### JOB PLACEMENT RATE (WITHIN 12 MONTHS GRADUATION)

For the past 5 years (2010-2014), the percentage of students who actively sought & found employment in the Radiologic Sciences was 99% (69 out of 72) within 12 months of graduation.

#### PROGRAM COMPLETION RATE

The percentage of students who completed the radiography program was:

Class of 2014: 94% (15 out of 16)

Past 5 years (2010-2014): 90% (72 out of 80)

AMERICAN REGISTRY OF RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY (ARRT) PASS RATE

For the past 3 years (2015-2017), the ARRT exam pass rate for first time examinees was 95% (39 out of 41).

JOB PLACEMENT RATE (WITHIN 12 MONTHS GRADUATION)

For the past 3 years (2015-2017), the percentage of students who actively sought & found employment in the Radiologic Sciences was 95% (37 out of 39) within 12 months of graduation.

PROGRAM COMPLETION RATE

The percentage of students who completed the radiography program was:

Class of 2017: 77% (14 out of 18)

Past 3 years (2013-2017): 82% (41 out of 50)
