

Making an International Payment

Southwest Baptist University values our international students and their families. To make it easier and more affordable for international students to pay their SBU accounts, we have partnered with TransferMate to offer an online international payment option.

- Faster payment posting to your student account (within 24 hours of payment completion)
- Local currency payment methods
- Great exchange rates, which are held for 48 hours so you know what you will pay
- 24-hour customer service from TransferMate
- 24-hour online tracking of payments

TransferMate lets you make international payments to Southwest Baptist University in your own local currency while receiving competitive foreign exchange rates. International students and their families can use this secure online payment method.

How to make an International Payment

- 1. Log in to your student account and select the TransferMate payment link
- 2. Choose the country you are paying from and your preferred payment method
- 3. Complete the payer details and set up an account
- 4. Make your payment following the provided instructions
- 5. Track your payment throughout the process

Note: There is a \$20 fee for domestics US to US transfers.

Set up an Authorized User

Students must grant parents or other payers authorized user access to allow them to make a payment on the student's behalf. Authorized users may view the account activity, make a payment, and set up a payment plan.

- 1. Log in to your student account
- 2. Click the "Authorized Users" link in the "My Account" menu
- 3. Click "Add Authorized User"
 - a. Enter the email address for the user you wish to add.
 - b. An automated email including a link, username, and temporary password will be sent to the email address you provided. Your authorized user must use this information to log in and set up a profile.
 - c. After the profile is set up, the authorized user will be able to make payments.
